With so many things happening in our world that we can't control, it can feel overwhelming and frustrating.

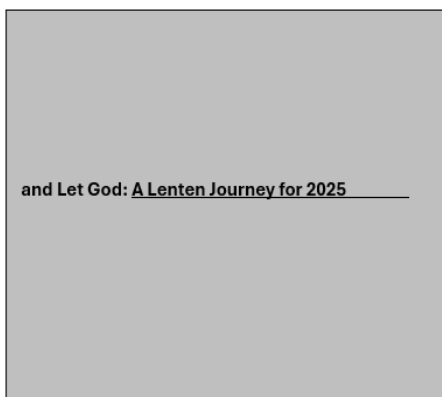
Now is the time to **LET GO** and **LET GOD** soothe our fears and calm our thoughts and emotions.

Plan to join us for a **Soup for the Soul** supper on Thursday, March 20 at 6:30pm in the Fellowship Hall.

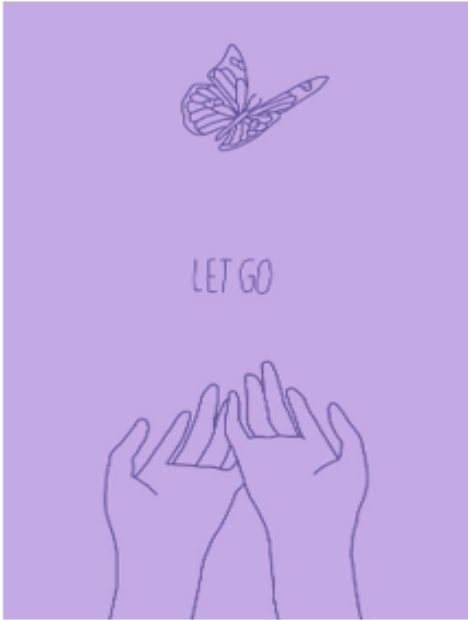

Shrove Pancake Supper - March 4

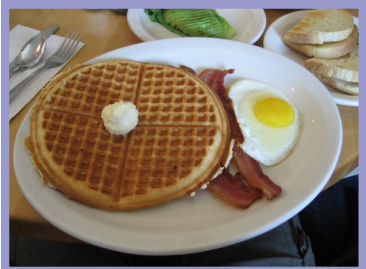

Reverend McGee Update

Pastor Clyde was called to St. Stephen for 22 years beginning in the 70's. During his call, St. Stephen rapidly increased its membership and several of the building expansions (including the current sanctuary) took place.

Unfortunately, Pastor McGee's health has recently become a concern.

So, I wanted to catch up with him and recently visited. During the visit, he told several stories of his time with St. Stephen. This includes the story of how one of the employees of the company installing the steeple on the sanctuary met his daughter (who was employed by a YMCA program that was run out of the church basement) in the hallway. They eventually married under the steeple that was being installed and now live less than a mile from Clyde and Peggy!



Pastor McGee, Peggy, and all who come to work, worship, or visit St. Stephen are each a blessing in their own way. It's amazing the connections and the relationships that the Holy Spirit has built through the people and the facilities!

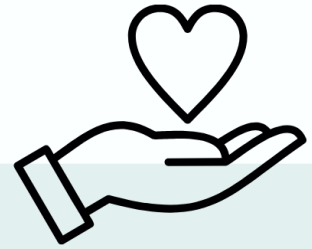

St. Stephen has a New Online Giving Application

To use Servant Keeper Online Giving, scan the QR code or use the URL. (above). Sign-up. Follow the directions and enter your personal email. Update password of your choosing. (An email will be sent to verify). The new password will need to have 8 characters, one capital, one symbol. Add the payment method: credit card or bank account transfer. Schedule. Choose account. Enter amount. Cover Processing Fee to pay for it out of your personal account. Choose frequency. (Weekly, Semi-Monthly, Monthly, Annual) SAVE.

You can change your giving amount or frequency whenever you choose. Once complete, you will receive a confirming email from Servant Keeper.

Servant Keeper will automatically add an app to your device so that you can change your options easily. It will default to a St. Stephen screen when opened and can be used for **Give Now** occasions when you may want to additionally give for other instances, i.e. Mission Support, Be the Change, etc. You can access your scheduled giving by clicking the '3 lines' in the upper left corner.

If you are currently giving through VANCO, you will need to CANCEL your Vanco giving. The church office cannot cancel the transaction. We will no longer be using Vanco as of February 28.

St. Pauly Textile, the company that provides our clothing shed, reported that in 2024, they had a record year. They collected over 200,000 lbs. of clothing every business day throughout the country. Our proceeds benefit Lydia's Pantry.

In 2024, our clothing shed made an impact:

- 40,800 lbs. of clothing were donated to our shed.
- This was enough to clothe 7,516 people all over the world.
- **St. Stephen received \$1,632.**
