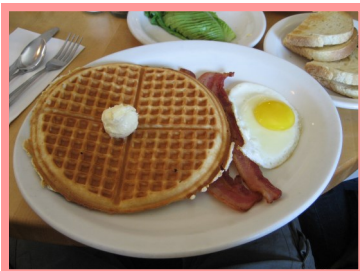

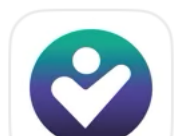
Vanco Faith Giving App
